

Debi Ballas Performing Arts Scholarship
Through The Augusta Players

Description:

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating high school senior to recognize their service to the Augusta Players and their community and to encourage continued growth in supporting the arts.

Value:

One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. Please note that scholarships will be paid with a check made out to the recipient's school of choice.

Eligibility:

- The applicant must have participated in at least one production, special event, or fundraiser with The Augusta Players or The Augusta Jr. Players.
- The applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- The applicant must have a minimum 2.5 overall GPA in high school
- The applicant must be planning on pursuing a major or minor in theatrical arts.
- The applicant must complete an essay about how the theatrical arts have had a positive impact on their life and how they believe the scholarship will help them achieve future educational and artistic goals.
- The applicant must have demonstrated the capacity to contribute to their community, as shown by activities and personal recommendations.
- The applicant must obtain three personal recommendations from supervising adults who are not directly related to the applicant.
 - One of these recommendations must come from a teacher concerning their academic abilities.
 - One of these recommendations must come from a director or other creative team member concerning their arts-based contributions or abilities.
 - One of these recommendations must be written by a supervising mentor concerning their character and support of or involvement in the arts.

Basis of the Award:

The award will be based on the applicant's essay, dedication, participation, and support of the arts, The Augusta Players and/or Augusta Jr Players, academic standards, and character qualities reflected in the applicant's letters of recommendation and application. Applications will be adjudicated by a committee of no less than four volunteers.

Application procedure:

1. Download and complete the application form provided. Please be sure to complete all of the questions, or the application becomes void.
2. Obtain three letters of recommendation and attach them to your application.
3. Completed applications, essays, and recommendation letters as one package must be returned to info@augustaplayers.org by Friday, April 26th. The winner will be notified by May 17, 2024, and the scholarship will be presented at the Auggie Awards on May 19, 2024.
